### Transportation from / to airport:

The ones who arrive to Istanbul Atatürk Airport, Taxis are available from the airport, which costs about approximately 30-35 € to Taksim Area, ,25-30.-€.- to Eminönü-Sultanahmet Area (Old City). Also Airport shuttles (HAVATAS) run every 30 minutes(as shown on the table below) to Taksim. and to Yenikapı IDO station (Ring shuttle) The ones who come to Sabiha Gökçen Airport, Airport buses (HAVATAS) run every 30 minutes during the day and at night (as shown on the table below), with a 50-60 minutes - journey to TAKSIM depending on the time of the day and the traffic (They cost about 5 € for each journey)

## How to travel in the city with public rail system:

Your hotels will be located in the city and easy access with public transportation

You can buy a travel card from metro stations or sale points which cost about 6.- TI (approx. 2,.-€) fix price and then you can load credit about 10.- EU (Approx. 25-30 TL) or more in order to use for public transportation as per metro, tram, funicular, public buses, public vessels, sea bus etc. If your credit finishes you can load more credit to the card.

How to travel from/to your hotel to Kadir Has Üniversitesi Cibali/Fatih Conference Center by Public Busses

From Taksim main bus station: Estimated time 25 minutes (bus number T55) stops at Kadir Has University bus stop and (Bus numbers 46ÇY, 69A or 70KY) stops at Unkapanı + Walk to Unkapanı-Kadir Has Ü (Fatih) (7minutes)

From Sultanahmet-Unkapanı: Estimated time: 15 minutes (Sultanahnet-Eminönü) Tram/(T1) + From Eminönü bus numbers are 99A, 99,36CE, 78, 146B, 33B, 36KE, 336E, 37E, 92, 38E, 97GE, 44B, 35, 82, 97A or 90 + Walk to Unkapanı-Kadir Has Ü (Fatih) (7minutes)

From Eminönü-Unkapanı: Estimated time: 10 minutes bus numbers are 99A, 99,36CE, 78, 146B, 33B, 36KE, 336E, 37E, 92, 38E, 97GE, 44B, 35, 82, 97A or 90 Walk to Unkapanı-Kadir Has Ü (Fatih) (7minutes)

#### Private Transfers:

The ones who request private transfers they should book their transfer in advance informing their arrival and departure time with flight number and the names of participants.

## Visas:

All foreign Participants should carry a valid passport and should verify visa requirements at the Turkish Consulate in their respective countries. Participants from those countries where there are no Turkish diplomatic representation can obtain their visa at the airport on arrival in Turkey. U.S Passport holders also can obtain their visa at the airport by paying in foreign currency.

## Money and Credit Cards:

The Turkish currency is Turkish Lira (TL.). The exchange rate changes daily. A rough estimate would be 1 €= 3.05 TL. Central Bank of Turkey daily determines the exchange rates for Turkish Lira, which are published in newspapers. All major international credit cards, such as Visa, MasterCard, Eurocard are accepted almost everywhere, American Express and Diners Club are accepted in some hotels, restaurants and shops but not commonly used.

## Banking and Currency Exchange:

Foreign currency can be exchanged on arrival at Istanbul Atatürk Airport. Banks in Turkey are open from 9.00 to 12.00 and 13.30 to 16.30 Monday through Friday. Some downtown banks provide extended banking hours. Banks are closed on Saturday and Sunday. Cash Point (ATM) services are available through most banks. Additional exchange facilities are also available at the airports, hotels and exchange bureaus in the city.

AC, 50 cycles, 220 volts The Electrical connection is 2-pin (Cylindrical) plug.

Turkish is the official language. In big cities many people speak English. As Latin alphabet is used it is easy to read street names and signs.
